

## High School Acting Competition Rules and Information

The fourth annual Competition is open to Georgia high school student's grades 9-12. Participants compete for scholarships and prizes by presenting a monologue and/or a scene. All selections must be from Shakespeare; One monologue and one scene per participant. Participants may compete individually or with their schools. Schools that send more than five participants are eligible for the Sweepstakes award: A free performance of the 2011 Will Power Ensemble. Participants are adjudicated by members of Georgia Shakespeare's award-winning acting ensemble. Trophies and medals are awarded for the top three finishers in the following categories: Best male monologue, best female monologue, best overall scene and the Sweepstakes Award (best school). Winners in the monologue and scene categories receive scholarships to 2011 High School Conservatory. Submit your registration form (available for download at [gashakespeare.org](http://gashakespeare.org)) and fee by February 11<sup>th</sup>.

-Monologues can be no longer than two minutes in length and must be in verse.

-Scenes are for two partners only and can be no longer than seven minutes in length. Prose and verse scenes are eligible.
