Grades 3-5

Students will explore the concept of working together as an ensemble. The class will culminate in a performance on the final day!

Georgia Shakespeare PLAYMAKERS II

Grades 6-9

A new class for middle schoolers! Create your own play through improvisation, games, and theatre exercises, and then perform it for an audience! Working as an ensemble, this group of 6th-9th graders will create an original piece, working both as playwrights - or playmakers - then as actors. The work will be guided by one of Shakespeare's own zany comedies, tied to a theme selected by the ensemble, and presented through the eyes of the group and their real life teen experiences. Improv, movement, poetry, music, and scripted scenes created by the PLAYMAKERS will be part of the final presentation, making **THE PLAY THE THING! Open to new and past participants!**

Grades 10-12

Participants will be exposed to the acting techniques that work best for each of the playwrights represented. The final presentations will be presented to the Artistic Director Richard Garner.
