

The second of the seasons IOM Swimming Association League Matches saw more Island Records falling, with the two regulars, Sports Aid recipients Laura Kinley and Charlotte Atkinson, adding to their tally, and a new name, Guy Davies, making his first appearance.

Fifteen year old Davies knocked a massive fifteen seconds off his time to win the open 200m breaststroke with two mins 34.66, taking over two seconds off the previous junior record that has stood since 1999.

Kinley, also fifteen, reduced the senior and junior figures in the corresponding ladies event, with her time of two mins 36.76 taking just over a second off her records, set the weekend before in Manchester. Later in the met she also bettered her own record times over 50m breaststroke with a time of 32.73.

Both Atkinson and Kinley have knocking on the door of breaking the one minute barrier for 100m freestyle over recent months, with Kinley being the first to achieve the target with 59.52 the previous weekend. Not to be outdone, it was Atkinson who led from the start in their head to head battle, to set new senior and junior island records with 58.29. Kinley was just slightly slower than the weekend before with 59.53.

Atkinson was also victorious in the fifteen and over 50m freestyle, in 27.17, and 100m butterfly with one min 05.21.

At the other end of the age scale, impressive wins came from nine year old Emma Hogdson in the 25m freestyle and 50m breaststroke, with times of 16.17 and 53.54 respectively; whilst one year up Harrison Katz won the 50m freestyle in 33.91.

Thirteen year old Ben Kebbell knocked almost three seconds off his previous best to win the 100m breaststroke in one min 16.92, in addition taking his age group 50m backstroke and finishing third in the open 200m breaststroke in 2 min 46.18, also a personal best time.

Tom Isaac was the winner of both the fifteen and over 50m freestyle and 100m butterfly, but had to settle for second in the open 100m freestyle behind Phil Harrison.. Zak Keig was the winner of the open 50m breaststroke, after a close race with Connor Christian.

Katie Callow was winner of both girls events in the fourteen years age group, whilst in the corresponding boys events James Hansford won the 50m freestyle and Luke Annett the 100m butterfly.

In the thirteen years girls' events the honours were shared with Samantha Titterton winning the 100mbreaststroke and Amy Kinley the 50m backstroke. Ciara Cassidy continued her winning run with victories in the twelve years 50m butterfly and

100m backstroke. Joel Watterson won the boys butterfly and James Cowin the backstroke.

For the eleven year olds the only event was the 200m individual medley, and both Maisie Short and Joshua Corteen had emphatic victories.

Other winners were Isabella Barnes (Southern) and Lauren Callow (Ramseian) who took the ten years olds 25m breaststroke and 50m freestyle respectively, and Southern swimmers Nickie Kelly-Bunyan and Matthew Humphrey who took the nine year olds 25m freestyle and 50m breaststroke.

A fast finishing Douglas team had to settle for second place behind Southern in the mixed 8 x 25m freestyle relay, whose winning time of one min 59.07 gave them a fifth of a second margin.
