Isle of Man Swimming Team Selection Statement

Selection nominations for the Commonwealth Games 2010 ('the Games') will be made from performances by eligible swimmers who satisfy the criteria set by Article 86 of the Articles of Association of the Commonwealth Games Association of the Isle of Man, as shown below.

Performances for nomination may be achieved in short course or long course events and to be considered must be at times equal to or faster than the consideration times for that course listed below. In addition to achievement of a time, a swimmer must satisfy the selection committee as regards their attitude and commitment to training; experience and ability to compete at national level events; ability to consistently perform at the required level; and commitment to the Games Team participation.

The period during which performances may be achieved commences on the 1st January 2009 and continues until close of entries for the Games in May 2010.

Swimmers are responsible for ensuring the Secretary of Isle of Man Swimming Association is advised of a performance where a consideration time is achieved. Full details must be provided including the date, meet, course, event & time (including splits) and a copy of the results for the event should be attached.

A performance or performances at a time equal to or faster than the consideration times; or a performance at a time equal to or faster than a consideration time of another competitor is no guarantee of nomination for selection to the Isle of Man Team.

The Selection Committee of Isle of Man Swimming Association will consider the performances and make a recommendation on nominations to the Executive Committee of Isle of Man Swimming Association. The nominations once ratified by the Executive Committee will be submitted to the Commonwealth Games Association of the Isle of Man ('CGA IOM') for team selection consideration. The decision of CGA IOM is final.

Isle of Man Swimming Association will nominate a Swimming Team Manager for the event

Selected swimmers may be offered the opportunity to compete in additional events at the discretion of the Swimming Team Manager and will be expected to participate.

Extract from the Articles of Association governing Commonwealth Games Association of the Isle of Man adopted 19th March 2008.

Article 86:

Eligibility for selection shall be in terms as set out in 'The Constitution of the Commonwealth Games Federation' under Article 'Conditions for representing a Country' (Presently Article 24) but modified for the Isle of Man selection purposes only as follows:-

- (a) A competitor must reach a standard as approved by the directors for the sport concerned (although this does not mean automatic selection);
- (b) Having been a resident on the Isle of Man for three years immediately prior to the date of the Opening Ceremony of the Celebration of a Commonwealth Games;
- (c) Shall demonstrate that he or she have a close identity with the Island by reason of immediate family and normal residence and the prospect of feed-back into insular sport; and must hold an Isle of Man Passport;



- (d) Any person gaining qualification as above and undertaking a programme of study, secondment or involved in military service out of the Island, shall be deemed a permanent resident for purposes of selection, provided he or she can demonstrate retaining an active connection with the Island.

Extract from the Constitution of the Commonwealth Games Federation – November 2007

Article 24

Eligibility

1. Subject to Article 24(2), as a condition of entry to compete in the Commonwealth Games, all competitors must be citizens or subjects of the Commonwealth Country that enters them and must:
 - (a) not be currently under disqualification or suspension by the Federation, or their respective Affiliated CGA or IF or under the World Anti Doping Code;
 - (b) comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Federation, their respective IFs and the World Anti Doping Code as may be modified and applied by the Federation to ensure that the overriding principles of the Commonwealth Games are observed.
2. Subject to Article 24(3), where a competitor was born in a Commonwealth Country that has common citizenship/passport with other Commonwealth Countries, the competitor may initially represent either the competitor's Commonwealth Country of Birth; or the Commonwealth Country of birth of his or her father or mother that shares the same citizenship/passport.
3. After having represented one Commonwealth Country at the Commonwealth Games, a competitor may not represent another Commonwealth Country unless he or she receives the approval of the Federation, the relevant IF and the Affiliated CGAs of the two Commonwealth Countries concerned.
4. It is the responsibility of all Affiliated CGAs to ensure that their competitors are fully aware of and comply with the eligibility rules of the Federation.
5. The Executive Board shall have the power to waive the provisions of Articles 24 (1-3) in its discretion.
