

Beckman Football Booster Information

We are pleased that your son will return for another season of Beckman Patriots Football and we are anticipating another exciting football season. This information summarizes important policies and expectations for the entire football season. Please carefully read the following information as some if it may be new this season. Communication of Important Dates and Information:

The responsibility to learn about important dates and information affecting the players rests with the players. The Beckman Football Boosters and coaches have created the following avenues of communication to help you stay informed:

- Our official website is www.beckmanfootball.com. This website is an important resource for you to learn more about the program. You will find links to up-to-date game information, as well as important dates, forms and other general information about our program.
- **Email.** Periodically, we will send information about important events and dates to the e-mail address you provide.
- **Flyers.** Flyers are sent home with the players throughout the year. Please remind your player about the importance of making sure you see flyers when they are distributed.
- <http://www.highschoolsports.net> is the official website Beckman High School uses for all sports programs. Log on and create your own user ID to view game schedules. You may register to receive updates via e-mail or mobile phone when there are any changes to games dates, locations or times.

The Beckman High School Super Boosters:

The Super Boosters is Beckman's non-profit umbrella organization for most athletic and activity groups on campus. This non-profit organization holds the 501 (3) (c) tax identification status, audits financial accounts and files end of the year tax returns for various booster groups. They approve all fundraising events and provide a forum to foster communication and networking between the individual groups.

Budget:

The Beckman Football Boosters was created in order to provide funds in support of the program when the school and Tustin Unified School District cannot. The football boosters host several fundraisers including:

Special Events and annual fundraisers:

- Player Commitment Fees
- New 12th Man Club
- Valley Forge Scrimmage
- Lift-A-Thon
- New Texas Hold'em Tournament and Silent Auction

Additional sources of revenue for the program come from ongoing revenue sources:

- Spirit Wear
- Snack Bar Sales
- Program Ads
- Banner Sales

**Varsity Home Game ticket sales go directly to the Associated Student Body account.
They are not part of the Beckman Football Budget.*

Summer Camp and Tustin Unified School District Transportation:

Summer Football Camp is from June 22nd through July 23rd. This camp is sponsored by the Tustin Unified School District. It is not necessary to attend camp to be a part of the Beckman Football Program, but is highly recommended for its conditioning benefits. The camp will consist of the following: strength training, agility, and speed training,

football conditioning skills and playbook instruction. This fee is made directly to the ***Tustin Unified School District*** and is not governed by the Beckman Football Boosters. Failure to pay this fee will result in the player not being allowed to participate in camp. The fee for this camp is \$200.00 and is due on **June 22nd**. This is not part of the player commitment fee.

Bus transportation fees for 2009 - 2010 will be \$145.00. This fee is charged by the school district and must be paid on or before Fall Registration. This fee is made directly to the ***Tustin Unified School District*** and is not governed by the Beckman Football Boosters, nor does the football program receive any profit. This is not part of the player commitment fee.

Beckman Football Financial Obligations and Commitments:

The sole purpose of the Beckman Football boosters is to make our players high school football experience as rewarding and enjoyable as possible. We do this by conducting fundraisers and planning team building events for the players benefit. The nice thing about our efforts is that every dollar raised goes directly into the program!

The summer/fall Spirit Package will be \$80.00. The Spirit Package must be paid in full before the player will be given any of their spirit pack. Once a spirit pack is given to the player, no refunds will be granted. Additional summer/fall gear will be available for sale throughout the year while supplies last. This is not part of the player commitment fee.

The Annual Player Commitment Fee is \$400.00 per player and is due on **August 22nd**. This fee can be offset by two fundraisers: Selling Ads in our Varsity Home Game Program and Banner Advertisement Sales. Program ad sales allow 50% of all ads fees to go toward Player Commitment Fees while banner sales allow \$100.00 per banner to go toward Player Commitment Fees. It is important to get participation in the program ads due to the costs to produce the Varsity Game Day Program and all players are encouraged to support the program sales ads. Please see Player Commitment Fees, the Program Ad and Banner Sales Flyers for details.

For those planning summer vacations, our vacation period free from required football activities is from July 26th through August 16th. On August 17th all players are expected to be at football practice. Please see the calendar for practice and special event details and times included in this packet.

Volunteers

If your son is on the football roster, you are a Beckman Football Booster! The Beckman Football Boosters are comprised entirely of unpaid volunteers. To accomplish all of our goals, every parent is expected to volunteer during the season. Volunteer hours will be tracked and reported to the Head Varsity Coach.

Volunteer sign-up sheets will be available today, during the Lift-A-Thon and at the Valley Forge Scrimmage. We will fill positions as we receive forms. Please hand in your forms as soon as possible. Carefully consider the many volunteer opportunities available. Volunteers help to create a first class experience for our players.
