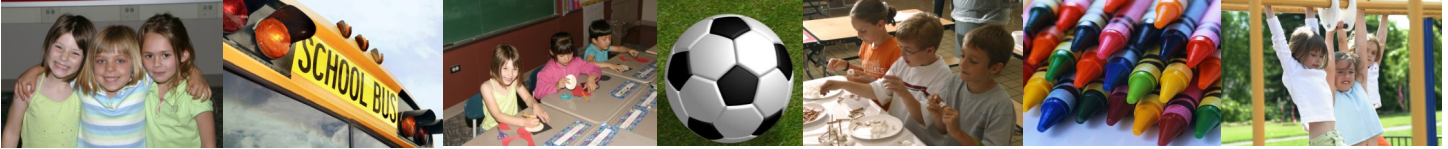

## The Summer Camp Program

## Optional Swim Trips & Field Trips



We will have a variety of fun-filled field trips throughout the summer. Some field trips will be on-site at the school and some will be off-site. ## Tuition

Tuition rates are \$36/day for full weeks or \$40/day for partial weeks. There is a 25% discount for siblings. There is a \$10 pool charge per week for those campers attending the pool on Wednesdays to cover transportation and admission to the pool. Field trips carry additional charges and are billed separately. Please see page 3 for field trip charges. Summer camp is billed in two segments divided in mid-July. **We are able to accommodate schedule changes when submitted by email at least 2 weeks prior to the desired date change. ## Registration Fee

Registration fees are non-refundable and are charged according to the following schedule:

Early Registration—\$25 per child through March 31, 2012

Discounted Registration—\$35 per child between April 1 and May 31, 2012

Registration—\$45 per child after May 31, 2012

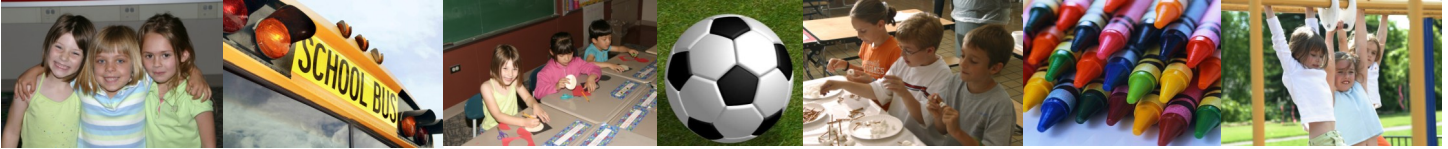
## How to Register
