

Department 19 — 4-H CLOTHING CONSTRUCTION

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Garments may have been worn but shall be laundered and pressed before being exhibited. Garment may be covered with a clear plastic bag. Each garment must be labeled with exhibitor's name and class number. At least one constructed outfit must be modeled in the Public Style Revue to receive premiums. Superintendents may grant exceptions for emergencies at their discretion. Pre-cut kits are acceptable. Garments receiving a Purple are eligible for the Kansas State Fair.

Recycled Clothing Project - An item made of at least 50% recycled material (recycled means reusing an existing item in a new way). Could be remaking/redesigning a garment, re-purposing a clothing item for a new use, etc. Must include sewing of some kind. A 3" x 5" index card MUST accompany entry describing the recycled materials and how they were used in the item.

Educational exhibits may be a poster, notebook, booth or other display showing and describing something learned, a project activity, etc. Maximum size for posters is 22" x 28".

A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in each level. Overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected for Levels I & II combined and for Levels III & IV combined.

A 4-H member may enter up to 6 total entries, being any combination of the following list of classes or educational exhibits.
