All breeds can be shown, list the breed on your entry form. Classes will be divided at the discretion of the rabbit committee.

Each rabbit must be identified with a permanent tattoo in the left ear. One animal per class except meat classes. Three animals of the same breed must be entered in meat classes. Minimum weight is 3 pounds and maximum weight is 5 pounds for meat classes. Maximum age for meat classes is 70 days. Rabbits entered in meat classes may not show in any other class. Exhibitors must carry their own rabbits to the show table. As per the ARBA Standard of Perfection, there will not be 6-8 month classes for breeds having a minimum ideal senior weight under 9 pounds.

Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in each section. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded overall.
