All breeds can be shown, list the breed on your entry form. Must have two animals to make a class. Classes will be divided at the discretion of the sheep committee.

Wethers and ewes may be shown as market lambs. Ewe lambs cannot be shown as both market and breeding stock. To be eligible for the Kansas State Fair or the Kansas Junior Livestock Show, lambs must have been nominated by **June 15, 2012**. By time of show, all market lambs must be slick shorn with an even length of wool covering above the hock and knee, head & belly excluded. Breeding sheep wool length is not to exceed 2 inches, per Kansas State Fair regulations.

Each class will be awarded a Champion and Reserve Champion. Overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded from all class Champions.
