**OPEN CLASS FRESH FLOWERS**

All exhibits must be grown or arranged by exhibitor.

1. Judging will be by an accredited flower show judge in accordance with the standard system in the Handbook for Flower Shows.
2. Exhibits may be replenished with fresh flowers anytime after judging is completed if exhibitor desires.
3. Flower forms may be made of fresh or dried plant material, but no artificial flowers, fruit, foliage or other artificial plant material may be used.
4. Exhibitors must furnish clear glass containers for specimen and collection entries.

**Section 1- GARDEN GROWN**

It is recommended but not required that individual plants or specimens be named with common variety names. In close competition, at the judge's discretion, extra point may be awarded to exhibits with named plants and/or specimens

**Section 4- FRESH ARRANGEMENT DESIGN**

1. Flowers and other materials used in design classes and arrangements may be obtained elsewhere than exhibitors own garden, but must be garden grown, not from a commercial greenhouse or flower shop.
  2. Accessories may be used in all arrangements except where they are specifically prohibited. Dried materials may be treated.
  3. Containers for arrangements may be of any type.
  4. All wreathes and wall hangings must have hangers attached.
