**Basic set-up** of tonic, sweet, sour, or soda and slice of lemon, lime, or cherry      Short or Tall      \$ 1.75  
**Martini:** dry vermouth, lemon twist or olive      **Manhattan:** sweet vermouth, Maraschino cherries      **Gimlet:** lime juice, lime slice  
**Old Fashioned:** sugar syrup, bitters, cherry, and orange slice      **Margarita:** Margarita mix, slice of lime, salted glass

### Red Wines

**Douglass Hill Merlot, Calif**      \$ 5.00 \$17  
*A smooth Merlot with berry aromas, flavors of jammy raspberries and vanilla. Good with steak, ribs, and fish tacos.*

**Dupond Merlot, Southern France**      \$ 7.75 \$29  
*Only Merlot grapes are used in this lovely wine, resulting in its soft, velvety texture. There are flavors of caramel, peppercorn, herbs and even a hint of clove.*

**Dante Pinot Noir, Napa Valley, Calif**      \$ 7.50 \$28  
*A superbly smooth balance of tart cherries and delicate fresh raspberries.*

**DeLoach Cabernet, Dry Creek Valley Calif**      \$ 7.25 \$27  
*A completely focused Cabernet. It delivers the flavors of cassis, toasty oak, and a suggestion of Brazilian coffee bean.*

**Dante Cabernet, Napa Valley Calif**      \$ 7.50 28  
*Black cherries, blackberries, and cedar create the big, meaty flavors of this Cabernet. Great with steaks and prime rib.*

**Legado Munoz Tempranillo, La Mancha, Spain**      \$ 7.75 \$29  
*This dynamite from Spain showcases the juicy red fruit of cherries, summer blackberries, spice and deep plums, all leading up to a powerful finish.*

**Notro Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina**      \$ 7.25 \$27  
*The Malbec grape in this wine is simultaneously dark yet bright. It's full of red fruit flavors but with an earthy, deep richness. Almost every red wine drinker will love this one.*

**Sangria, Spain**      \$ 5.25 \$18 pitcher  
*Yes, it's true, and no wine snobs allowed! This is fondly called the 'porch pounder' that we serve over ice with a fresh orange slice. You'll laugh, and then order it by the pitcher!*

**L'Orangerie Red, France**      \$ 7.25 \$27  
*A table of red wine drinkers but not sure who gets veto power? This is the red that preserves the democracy. It's a vibrant ruby color that delivers a terrific balance of fruit, spice, summer herbs and grace. Just order it as "the orange red."*

<b>Douglass Hill Chardonnay, Calif</b>	\$ 5.00	\$17
<i>This Chardonnay showcases a balance of fruit flavors from start to finish: apples, pears and a hint of vanilla</i>		
<b>Capri Chablis, Calif</b>	\$ 5.00	\$ 9 carafe
<i>A bright, sunny colored Chablis that is right between sweet and dry. The carafe is two generous glasses</i>		
<b>Beringer White Zinfandel, Calif</b>	\$ 5.00	\$17.50
<b>Cellar 8 Pinot Grigio, Calif</b>	\$ 7.50	\$28
<i>You'll find this wine to be crisp and light with tastes of cherry, grapefruit and lime.</i>		
<b>Shine Riesling, Germany</b>	\$ 7.25	\$27
<i>The tastes of peach, pear, and apple shine through this liquid gold colored Riesling. Silky smooth with just enough sweetness to remind you of a soft, warm May day.</i>		
<b>Michael Pozzan Sauvignon Blanc, Russian River, Calif</b>	\$ 7.75	\$29
<i>Melon and citrus. Smooth from start to finish without any edginess - - just like our favorite dinner companions.</i>		
<b>Sancet, France</b>	\$ 8.50	\$29
<i>Four grapes blend to make an amazing quartet of music for your mouth: delicate, spicy, floral, and fruit. Think Vivaldi's Four Seasons and you'll have it about right.</i>		
<b>L'Orangerie Chardonnay, France</b>	\$ 7.25	\$27
<i>This is your stainless steel fermented Chard, no oak whatsoever and is of 100% Chardonnay grapes. Aromas of grapefruit and peaches are followed by lemon, with a smooth buttery finish. Just pronounce it like lingerie and you've got it.</i>		
<b>Dante´ Chardonnay, Napa Valley, Calif</b>	\$ 7.50	\$28
<i>A rich oaky Chardonnay: Full bodied, creamy and filled with tropical fruit aromas and flavors.</i>		
<b>Prosecco Sparkling Wine, Italy</b>	\$ 9	
<i>This demi-bottle of sparkling Italian wine is a terrific balance of sweetness and flavor. It's a generous glass and a half, just the right amount for your private celebration, or to share. Use this to salute anything - even just a lovely sunset here with friends.</i>		
<b>Moscato d'Asti Sparkling Wine, Italy</b>	\$22	
<i>The wine maker, Patrizia, harvests her grapes for this wine when they are at an advanced age because they are sweeter and more balanced. Don't you hope that Patrizia would see the same in us? You'll love this wine as it's a very fresh sparkler that's delicate and delicious.</i>
