What is included in the registration fee?

What We Plan To Do...

Students will come together for 6 days and 7 nights.



We will check in on Saturday night and get our team assignments.

Sunday morning, the teams are in local churches, worshipping and fellowshiping as missionaries.



Monday morning, bright and early, we will head to the job sites. There we will work to revitalize homes pre-selected Rebuilding Together and the Mid-State Baptist Association. Students will return to the host location for fellowship, Bible study, dinner and worship.

This will repeat each day of the week with variations in the evening. Wednesday afternoon and evening are “feel” time to fellowship as a team.



Friday will be the last work day and students will leave the host location and return home Saturday morning.

During this week, students will have the opportunity, and will be encouraged, to witness to the people that they are helping while they “Show the Love of God” through their actions.
