The newsletter deadline is January 7th.

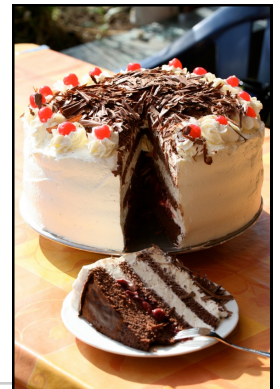
Rod Phelps said that Tour Nebraska will be based in Hasting this year, it will be the first weekend in June. Contact Rod with any questions or for more information.


Ladies and Gentlemen— The Trivia Results


CARDS OR FLOWERS

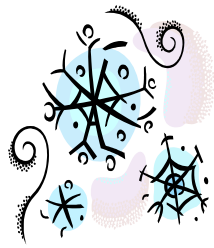
Don't forget to bring your canned goods to the next meeting. Margaret Otley is collecting them to take to the Food Pantry.

GIFT EXCHANGE
