
As always DRIVE SAFE AND KEEP THE SHINEY SIDE UP AND THE DIRTY SIDE DOWN.

On Saturday May 6th is the 16th Annual Alvo Volunteer Fire Department Car Show with registration from 9:00 AM to Noon. Also on Saturday May 6th is the Norris High School Auto Show located at 25211 South 68th Street.

There is the Berean Car Show on Saturday May 13^{th} at the Lincoln Berean Church parking lot on 70^{th} and Highway 2. Registration is from 8:30 - 11:00 AM. For \$10.00 there is also a Car Corral for those that have a vehicle to sell. For more information contact me at 402-489-8853.

There is a show & shine at a nursing home is on Monday May 15th at the Lancaster Rehabilitation Center located at 1001 South Street from 1:00-4:00 PM.

On Saturday May 20th there is the Catholic Social Services Car Show & Shine at 23rd and O Streets from 9:00 AM-3:00 PM. There is no fee for participants or spectators except for a free will offering.
