

James Farm Frontier Revolver Shoot

Range Safety Briefing

Read this to shooters before any firing starts.

1. Take all firing line commands from Range Officers. **(Identify the range officers)**
2. Explain the far right, far left, and vertical safety limits. Shooters never fire or point their revolvers outside of these limits. **(Demonstrated)**
3. Unless the weapon is holstered, shooters will always point the muzzle of the revolver downrange whenever on the firing line. **(Demonstrated)**
4. Do not place the trigger finger within the trigger housing area **(Demonstrated)**, until ready to fire.
5. Never touch your revolver while personnel are downrange or in front of the firing line.
6. Load the revolver only on the command of the Range Officer. Cartridges or Percussion Caps may ONLY be loaded on the firing line. Percussion revolvers may be charged at the loading tables.
7. Require hearing/eye protection or when within 25 yards of the firing line.
8. Before leaving the firing line, check your revolver to make sure it is unloaded. Unloaded revolvers may be placed in holsters.
9. Consider the revolver loaded at all times, even in the break areas. Never point the revolver at anyone.
10. Anyone observing an unsafe act will immediately call CEASE FIRE, place his/her revolver in a safe condition on the wood in front of their firing point or in a holster. **(Demonstrated)**
11. Whistle signals immediate cease fire. **(Demonstrated)**
12. Visual signal of cease fire. **(Demonstrated)**.
13. There is NO smoking anywhere on the James Farm.
14. Explain the layout of loading tables for cap and ball revolvers and benches for cartridge revolvers.
15. First Aid Kit location
16. Please put trash in proper receptacles.
