## From the Rector's Desk....

### Thanksgiving and Response

One of the joys of life is to give from what is entrusted to us, to the work of God in the world. October brings two important tasks for the members of Christ's body, the church. One is to catch up on our pledge commitments for the current year's operations of ministry. The second is to fill out and turn in a pledge card indicating our anticipated giving for the coming year.

October, November and December are very important months for people to plan their giving to allow Grace Church to complete its financial commitments, and ministry programs for the coming year. In the final quarter we can meet the goals we set for revenues, allowing us to operate with confidence to meet our fixed expenses, and our all important expenses for program ministry.

By the mid point of this month, we hope to meet goals for our pledge campaign and planning for next year. The Stewardship dinner was beautiful, and the organizers and nine table hosts created a wonderful event enjoyed by over sixty people in attendance. Elmer Dezso's talk at the dinner was inspirational. The pledges turned into to date have us at 56% of our goal for the number of parish households, and at 62% of our dollar target pledge revenues. Those goals are in reach. In the next two weeks, all are encouraged to consider making a pledge so that, together, we can fully meet these goals of 80 pledges, and \$215,000 in pledge revenue for 2012.

Our giving to God's work through the church is mainly about two things. It is a process of recognition of blessings of life, and a tangible response of thanksgiving. When we make a habit of thanking God in our prayers, and pondering all God's blessings we enjoy, we are moved to symbolize our gratitude by giving back to God. One effective symbol is to give back to God through service to others, that is, through benevolent action. The other critical symbol is our donations for God's work through the church. Let us all find ways to thank God continuously, through our prayers of gratitude and our generous giving.

**Grace Episcopal Church Vestry Meeting Minutes****September 20, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Members present were: Wane Bell, Junior Warden, Margaret Barrier, John Bergmann, Mark Patterson, and Donna Tate. Meeting facilitator, David Price, Rector, opened with a short prayer.

Patterson moved to accept the August, 2011 minutes. The motion was seconded by Bergmann. Motion carried.

**REPORTS:** Treasurer's report for August 2011 was presented. Brief discussion followed. Tate moved to accept the treasurer's report subject to audit. Bell seconded. Motion passed.

Rod Dockal and Tommy Peebles arrived during the rector's report.

Fr. Price presented the rector's report. The average Sunday attendance is 104. The attendance for the Sunday Service of the September 11 Remembrance Memorial was 170. New Sunday School curriculum has been purchased and the first session has begun with classes for Pre-K to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades, and Junior High. Assistants and co-leaders are still needed. The first session runs until Advent in November. Fr. Price then moved to an update on the contract with Ryan Perry, the youth minister. First Presbyterian has opted out of the shared youth program effective September 31, 2011. Other churches in Alvin are being approached about joining the program. Discussion followed. Peebles moved, with a second by Patterson, that Grace Episcopal Church pay for one-half of the outstanding First Presbyterian share on Perry's contract through 2011. Discussion followed. Motion passed unanimously.

The Senior Warden's report was presented for Hefner by Tate. The pumpkins arrive for The Pumpkin Patch on Saturday, October 1. Pallets will be picked up next Monday. Hefner has contacted a trucking company that has a fork lift on the trailer so we will get them off the truck quickly. The scouts have been contacted and should be out in force. Hefner hopes to find volunteers to make hotdogs for lunch like last year. Pumpkins will cost more and we do not know what to expect with regards to size and price due to the Texas drought. We are offering two children's art classes to be held Monday through Thursday evening in the Pavilion and an adult painting class on Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. We will not be having a carnival this year since this is the first year with the playground. The playground will be the big attraction for the children. Hefner will have a bean bag toss out on the weekends for something more for children. We are hosting Miss Marjorie's Ukulele Band on Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> and we will have barbecue sandwiches and cobbler with ice cream. We will need help getting things set up and taken down on October 22<sup>nd</sup>. Peebles accepted Hefner's request to be the announcer for the group, complete with bow tie. Hefner thanked the vestry for all of their support and work. Patterson added that the ukulele band will perform at 4:00 PM on October 22.

Bell presented the Junior Warden's report. He said that Dockal has reprogrammed the thermostat in the church. Several men have worked on the gutters on the pavilion, trying to fit them with screens. This may need to be contracted out next year due to problems. Dockal and Bell are working on the gas lamp line in The Bishop's Garden (the courtyard). Dockal added to the Junior Warden Report that work is ongoing on the fuse issue with the air conditioning unit.

**OPEN ISSUES:**

Three candidates (Mary Smith, Aubry Stokes, and Katie Stokes) have agreed to run for vestry for 2012. Three more candidates are needed. The election is November 13, 2011. Meet the candidates is November 6, 2011. The Ministry Appreciation Banquet is November 6, 2011.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

We have received the Diocesan Assessment and Missionary Asking from the diocese. Summing the diocesan assessment and the missionary asking leaves a total that is down from 2011. Discussion followed.

Fr. Price presented a pastoral care update on CarolAnn Mills, Priscilla Clark, and Jim Reimer. He praised S. Wayne Mathis in his work in pastoral care and as a Lay Eucharistic Visitor.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

There was no unfinished business. The next meeting was set for October 18, 2011, at 7:00 PM

Peebles moved to adjourn, with a second by Dockal. Motion passed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:17 PM.
