Anyone wishing to join us for dinner before is welcome. We will be meeting at Pineapple Joe’s US 1 in Fort Pierce.



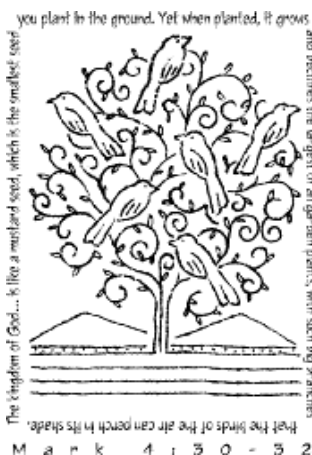
