From the Pastor's Desk

I want to take this opportunity to give you an update on the building of a new daycare building. As you know, we voted to budget \$350,000 out of the \$630,000 given to us from Linda Hayes to build a new daycare building. When we voted, we believed we had budgeted more than enough to complete the building. It was understood that the committee in charge of building the daycare building could not spend any money over the \$350,000 without approval of the church. As was spoken about in the April business meeting, the building process has been met with numerous roadblocks and setbacks, which have delayed the building process. We were finally going to begin on Monday, April 12th, but four days before we were to begin, we received more information concerning certain codes that were not going to be met in the new building. The codes relate to the Texas Accessibility Standards of the Architectural Barriers Act. The challenge now is that in order to meet the codes, we will have to add certain elements to the building, which will push the price tag over \$350,000. Given the circumstances and increase in cost, the committee met to begin thinking about what to do next, and the issues were discussed in the April business meeting. I was very pleased with the tone of the questions and comments in the April business meeting even though everyone was not in agreement concerning the next steps. Let me encourage you to come to the May business meeting on May 16th after the evening service where the committee will bring a proposal or proposals for the next steps. Let me also encourage you to feel free to ask any questions to me or members of the committee (Allen Temple, Russ Pilgrim, Karen Sikora, Susie Winn, and Anne Garner), especially if you have heard something and need clarification. While I wish the process would have been smoother until now, I also see this as an opportunity to clarify our next steps and trust God to guide our church. I hope through this process we will listen to different viewpoints, show grace to one another, and make decisions focused on reaching out to our community with the good news of Jesus Christ.
