So when we go to Jesus and ask what has already been paid for and we should expect it to be delivered. Is 53:5 *"But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed."* What are you waiting for? ## CHRISTIAN CUSS OR CURSE WORDS

*Your words are the most powerful thing you possess, with them you can bless or curse, you can condemn or save. Any word we speak that is contrary to God's Word is profanity. The Apostle Paul wrote to young Pastor Timothy to "Avoid those who use profane language." Leviticus 18:20 tells us that "Thou shalt not profane the name of the Lord thy God" Many of us say phrases everyday not realizing we are using Christian cuss/curse words. Let's look at some in this continued message from last month :*

6. **"I Can't"** If you say this, then you should wash your mouth out with soap. Most of the time you really mean is "I won't." Think of how many times you have slipped with this curse word: Come join us for prayer (I can't); Forgive your brother (I can't); Reach out to your neighbor (I can't). This word is not in God's vocabulary but 'I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.'

7. **"You Don't Love Me"** Those who say this do not understand the true nature of love and their heavenly Father. Many times we say this to our parents, spouses or pastors because we live in our feelings and don't want to face the truth of our own insecurities. Jesus is love and He is truth. He confronts us to change because He loves us, many times using other people.

8. **"Maybe"** This curse word is double-mindedness and uncertainty. The Bible says that a double-minded man

will receive nothing from the Lord. God is not a 'maybe' God but "The promises of God are yea and amen!"

9. **"We've always done it this way"** This is one of the worse and profane curses in the church because "the traditions of men have made us powerless." We will never grow and mature without change. The Lord's desire is to take us from "Glory to Glory." If the cloud is moving, we must move with the cloud of God's presence and purpose.

10. **"I'm afraid of what others will think"** This cursing is 'Idolatry.' It is putting people and what they say and think before God. The Apostle Paul said, "Those who are true servants of God cannot be man pleasers." You must find your full acceptance and affirmation from your Heavenly Father. People will slander, criticize, gossip about you especially if you dare to step out and do something and be real disciples for Christ. Somebody has to stand up. All I need to know is what my Heavenly Father thinks and says about me and His Word promises that "His thoughts toward me are always good!"

### THE UPRISING

**The control of our will begins with us.** Our will controls our feelings. Feelings derive from our will. Feelings have no creative moral character; therefore they must sympathize and follow the directions and actions of our will. Feelings cannot overtake and control our will, though they are linked. Our will places a demand on our feelings to obey, trust and submit. This is especially true in relating to what God wants to do in our midst. This is true in salvation, sanctification and so much more true in REVIVAL. Our feelings are not called to enter in to what God is doing, but our will is. When we resist the Lord's coming with our will, a spirit of rebellion is released and made manifest through our feelings. If we do not understand these principles of our will, then we will only follow our feelings, which are then controlled by a spirit of rebellion towards the new and fresh things that God wants to do in our midst. This is also called a religious spirit. When we give up instantly and surrender our will at once to a move of God, the feelings that sometimes we make the mistake of waiting for, will come because they are of God and they provide a flow and release for what captivates our will which is embracing the move of the Lord. The truth is that feelings do not come as an invitation to enter into what God is doing, but as a by product of our will's decision to embrace the new thing that God is doing in our midst. The invitation comes from God, is accepted by our will and made manifest by our actions and emotions. What God requires is a present, now, act of our mind that directs our will. This is the turning point from us controlling our feelings to embracing God's move with our will. God calls us to turn from status quo feelings to a mindset of embracing the anointing that God wants and is going to pour out on us. **The choice is yours.**

**The Prayer Habit**

The Apostle Paul instructed the saints in the church of Colosse to “continue in prayer and watch in the same with thanksgiving.” (Col. 4:2) The Philips translation gives an interesting slant on this portion by reading “always maintain the habit of prayer. Be alert and thankful as you pray.” A habit is something that is done regularly and repeatedly. An evil life is a life consisting of evil habits. A good life consists of good habits. The best habit any person can have is the “Prayer Habit.” Have you ever stopped to consider some of your regular morning habits. For many it is the eager anticipation of that first cup of ‘Hot Joe,’ to another it may be a refreshing shower, checking Facebook or catching the morning news. It has been said that if you do something regularly and repeatedly for 21 days you have just established a new habit. May I suggest adding to your routine or habits one which is not only positive but will change your life forever. Early morning prayer is the habit of so many great men of God: Abraham in Gen 22:3; Moses in Ex 8:20; Joshua in Josh. 3:1; Job in Job 5:1 and of course our ultimate example, Jesus in Mark 1:35. Consider the prayer of David, a man after God’s own heart, “My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, Oh Lord in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee and I will look up...in the morning shall my prayer come before thee...I will rise before dawn and cry for help. I will wait for thy word...cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning...I myself will awake early. Early I will seek thee.” Set your alarm and give your day first to the Lord and I guarantee it will be the best habit you’ve ever had!
